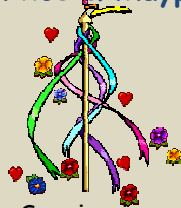


There is a Whole School Mass this Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April for 'Good News'. Friday's Assembly is a Headteacher Assembly.
