Cross Country Race

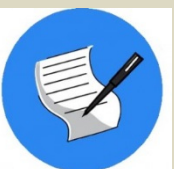


A reminder that there is a Cross Country race at Prestwold Hall this Saturday 29th October. Good Luck to all the runners!

Empty Plastic Bottles

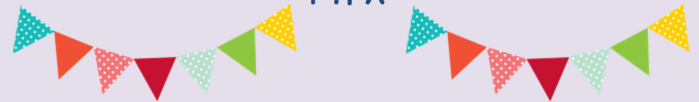
Year 4 pupils will need empty plastic bottles (any size) for a science experiment on Thursday afternoon (27th). Please rinse out before sending in, thank you.
