Year 5 Newsletter Lent term 2


Welcome back after the half term holiday. It's hard to believe that we are half way through the school year! As always we have lots of exciting things planned in




the run-up to Easter. We have welcomed 3 new children into year 5 this year, and are now up to our capacity of 30 in the class!
