









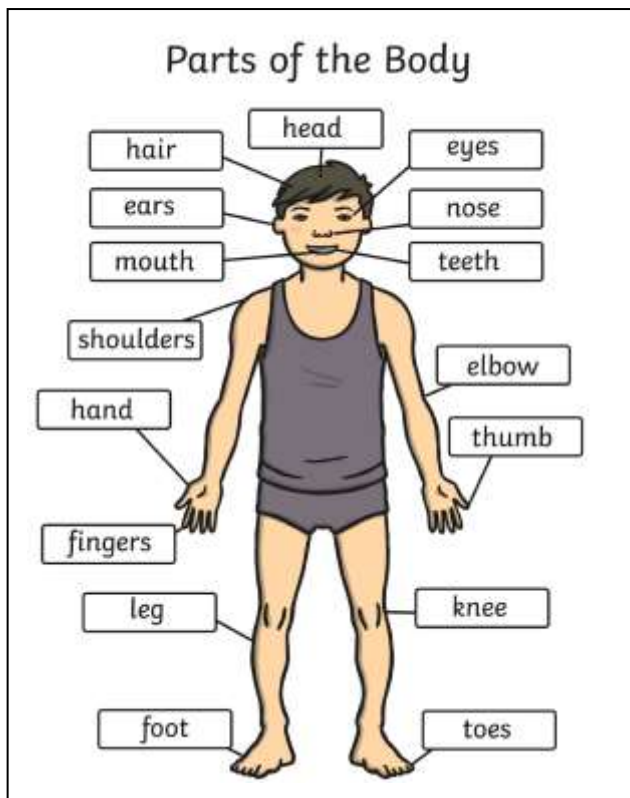





Animals including Humans

Animal Classification		
Amphibian	Amphibians live in the water and on land and have smooth, slimy skin.	 frog  newt
Reptile	Reptiles breathe air and have scales on their skin.	 snake  tortoise
Fish	Fish live and breathe under water. They have scaly skin, fins and gills.	 shark  goldfish
Mammal	Mammals are animals that breathe air, have fur or hair and feed on their mother's milk as babies.	 human  dog
Bird	Birds have a beak, two legs, feathers and wings.	 penguin  chicken



Carnivores eat mostly other animals.	
Omnivores eat both plants and other animals.	
Herbivores only eat plants.
