### Free School Meals/Pupil Premium

The deadline for applying for a first-time school admission is 15 January 2023. You must also submit a *Supplementary Information Form* to every Catholic secondary or primary school you apply for if you wish to be considered under a faith criterion. Supporting evidence must also be supplied.
