

Free School Meals/Pupil Premium

The school receives funding to help pay for staff to support childrens' learning as well as resources for pupils who receive free school meals and or pupil premium. Pupils who are eligible receive a free hot meal, access to free school uniform, free school trips and discounted residential trips as well as an allowance to spend on after school clubs etc. During this cost-of-living crisis we are all experiencing, it is important to get access to any extra funding you may be entitled to.

School Admissions

The deadline for submitting your application to Secondary School is 31 October. The deadline for applying for a first-time school admission is 15 January 2023. You must also submit a Supplementary Information Form to every Catholic secondary or primary school you apply for if you wish to be considered under a faith criterion. Supporting evidence must also be supplied.
