Free School Meals/Pupil Premium

The deadline for applying for a first-time school admission is 15 January 2023. You must also submit a *Supplementary Information Form* to <u>every</u> Catholic secondary or primary school you apply for <u>if you wish to be considered under a faith criterion</u>. Supporting evidence must also be supplied.
