World Book Day

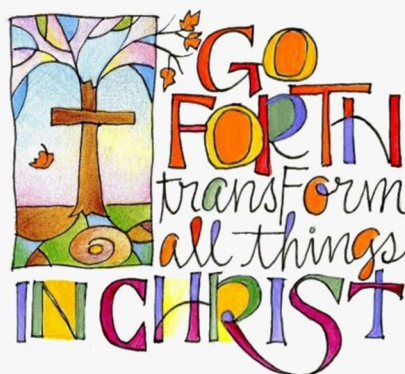
We will be celebrating World Book Day on Friday 3rd March. A Class Dojo has been posted with details of the theme (for dressing up and mask making).
