
## Year 1 October 2022

This half term our topic is "The Wheels on the Bus."

The first part of the term will look at the story Owl Babies which links to our RE focus of Belonging. We will then create some work around Autumn linked to our Science work on Seasons. After that we will look at the story of the Naughty Bus and use it to discover more about our school and local area to link with our geography work. If you are able to spot buses around the local area then that will give your child some context for our work this term.





In RE this term we are finishing off our topic about Belonging. We will then be learning about Judaism as one of our Other World Faiths. Our final topic for this term will be 'Waiting' during Advent.

In Maths we are continuing to learn Addition and Subtraction and will begin to move onto place value up to twenty. Shape will be our next topic this term. Simple 2d and 3d shape spotting can be very helpful so that children can identify shape with everyday life and become familiar with shape names and properties.

A reminder that PE is on Monday and Friday and on those days children can still wear their polo shirt and joggers for ease when changing into kits. Children should now be in shirt and tie with St Peters jumpers or cardigans for normal winter uniform. School fleeces are allowed but not to be worn inside school.

A reminder to practice spellings with your child using a look, cone rectangular prism pyramid cover, write method and the test will happen on Fridays. Other homework will be set on a Tuesday to be returned the following Monday.
