Children must attend school regularly to ensure that the maximum benefit is obtained from the education provided.

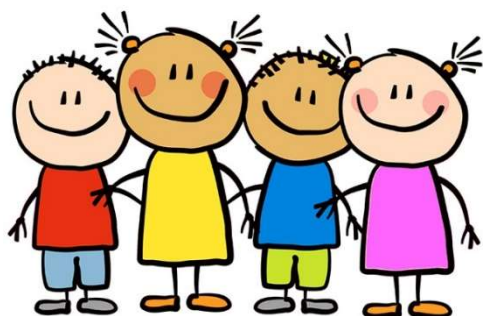

It is usually appropriate to send children to school with mild respiratory illnesses. This would include general cold symptoms: a minor cough, runny nose, or sore throat.
