

# <u>Year 2 Advent Term 2</u>

Welcome back. I hope you have all had a restful half term holiday.



## Literacy

Our new topic is Superheroes. We will read the story of Aisha the Superhero. We will sequence the story, write a comic strip, a newspaper report and finally some riddles. Our weekly grammar lessons will focus on commas in a list, adjectives and nouns and finally conjunctions. Spellings will cover a variety of patterns starting with kn and gn at the start of words then ge and dge at the end of words, before moving onto wr, u sound spelt o, or spelt a before I,II and finally several end of word letter patterns to include I, II, le, el, il and al. These will be sent home for the whole half term and can be found in your child's homework book. As we move towards the end of the half term we will share a fictional story about Sammy the Street Dog and finally a Christmas based story called A Christmas Collar.

#### <u>Science</u>

After completing our topic Animals including Humans we move onto Uses of Everyday Materials. We will identify and compare materials for particular uses and find out how the shapes of solid objects can be changed. A key learning sheet will be sent home and should be shared regularly with your child as part of their weekly homework.

# <u>RE</u>

After completing our topic of Signs and Symbols we move onto our other faith topic which is Judaism. Our final topic is Preparing. We will think about how we prepare for Christmas and the events around the birth of Jesus.

Our class will be leading the whole school Act of Worship on <u>Friday 3rd November at</u> <u>9.15am</u> in the school hall. Parents are welcome.

We also look forward to preparing for and performing our Nativity with Foundation Stage and Year 1 at church on <u>Thursday 14th December 2023 at 2 pm.</u>

## <u>Maths</u>

In Maths we are continuing with addition and subtraction, introducing the children to using the column method. We then move onto shape and finally money.

#### <u>History</u>

This half term we start our first History topic of the year and a key learning sheet will be sent home which should be shared regularly with your child. Our topic is The Great Fire of London. We will learn the facts about the fire, use different sources to ask and answer questions, including the diary of Samuel Pepys, write poems and create collages. We will also be welcoming a real fireman into school to tell the children about the role of the fire service and try on some uniforms.

## Music

This half term the children will begin to learn to play the recorder. We will have a weekly lesson each week this half term and then again in Lent Term 2 and Pentecost Term 2. Recorders are provided by school.

#### <u>Homework</u>

Homework and spellings will be sent home on a Friday, with homework to be returned by the following Wednesday. This will usually alternate between a piece of maths and a piece of Literacy. Spelling tests will continue to be every Friday morning. Remember to keep working through the Year 1 words your child doesn't know, perhaps picking 1 or 2 to focus on each week. Your child will also have a book on Bugclub and you should continue to use Timestables Rockstars. It is also really important that you hear your child read regularly. Reading books will be changed on a Monday and Thursday.

# <u>PE</u>

PE is on a Monday and Friday. Our new units are Gymnastics – Parts High and Parts Low and Games – Making Up a Game. Remember to send your child in joggers, polo shirt and school shoes. They should not be wearing any jewellery. They should have shorts, tshirt and pumps in their bag which remains in school.
