

This half term our topic is "The Wheels on the Bus."

In English we will be reading the story *Naughty Bus* and be using it to discover more about our school and local area this links with our Geography topic. If you are able to spot buses around the local area then that will give your child some context for our work this term. We will then create some work around Autumn linked to our Science work on Seasons. After that we will look at the story *Owl Babies* which links to our RE focuses of Belonging and waiting.

In RE this term we are finishing off our topic about Belonging. We will then be learning about Judaism as one of our Other World Faiths. Our final topic for this term will be 'Waiting' during Advent.



In Maths we are continuing to learn Addition and Subtraction and will begin to move onto place

value up to twenty. Shape will be our next topic this term. Simple 2d and 3d shape spotting can be very helpful so that children can identify shape with everyday life and become familiar with shape names and properties.

A reminder that **PE is on Monday and Friday** and on those days children can still wear their polo shirt and joggers for ease when changing into kits. Children should now be wearing winter uniform therefore they will need to wear a shirt or blouse and a tie, a St Peters jumper or cardigan. School fleeces are allowed but not to be worn inside school.

A reminder to practice spellings weekly for test on Fridays. We also expect children to be reading at least 3 times a week and practising the sounds they have learnt. These can be found on the phonic sheets that come home with your child. Other homework will be set on a Tuesday to be returned the following Monday.

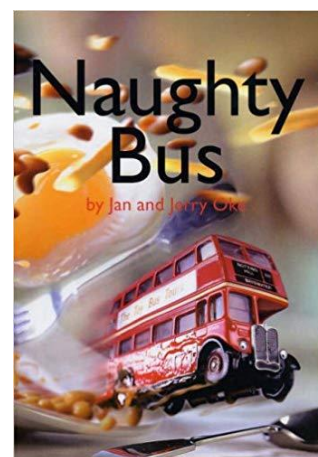
