Children must attend school regularly to ensure that the maximum benefit is obtained from the education provided.

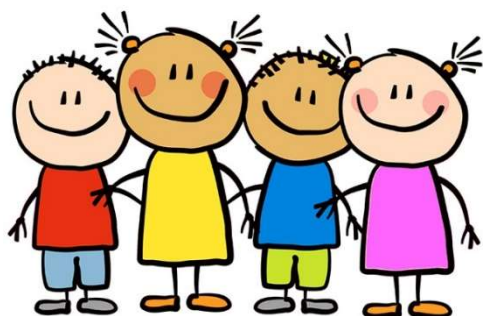
Our Whole School Attendance is currently
