Dear Parents,

Happy New Year! We hope you all had a wonderful relaxing Christmas. Once again, we have a very exciting and busy term to look forward to.

In Literacy this half term, our writing topic is "Escape from Pompeii" linking our writing with our History topic. We will be looking at myths and other stories and information from the Roman era. In Grammar, we will continue with our discrete weekly sessions learning how adverbs and prepositions can be used to make our writing more interesting. Children will still have their home reading books and will visit the library or choose from our class library a book to read for pleasure. In **spellings** we continue learning the Year 3/4 words and learn about homophones, ei, eigh, ey words and the sub prefix.

**Maths** will continue with our focus on multiplication and division, moving on to length and perimeter.

We will also continue to test the children on their 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 times tables and related division facts. Please keep practising these using the TT Rockstars app.

In Science our topic is forces and magnets including comparing how things move on different surfaces and recognising that some forces need contact, but magnetic forces can act at a distance.

Our **RE** focus will first be on 'Journeys' where we will be thinking about our journeys through the seasons and how we can help others on their journeys. We will then move on to Sharing and Listening, a topic where we will reflect on how Jesus gave his 'all' for us.
