# <u>Literacy</u>

Our new book this half term is The Bear Under the Stairs. The children will write letters, their own version of the story and information texts. We will then move onto The Minpins by Roald Dahl which will continue into next half term. Our weekly grammar lessons will focus on sentence types, followed by turning adjectives into adverbs. The focus in spellings is on suffixes including adding er, est, ing, ed, y and es.

## Science

We continue with our topic on Materials with the children investigating the most suitable materials for a PE kit and then an umbrella. After that, we start a new topic about plants. The children will begin to investigate what plants need to grow. Remember to share the key learning sheets with your child as part of their homework. ### RE

Our first topic is Books where we will learn about the parts of the bible and the appropriate responses when we hear from the bible. We then move onto our next topic Thanksgiving
