Animal Classification		
Amphibian	Amphibians live in the water and on land and have smooth, slimy skin.	 
Reptile	Reptiles breathe air and have scales on their skin.	 
Fish	Fish live and breathe under water. They have scaly skin, fins and gills.	 
Mammal	Mammals are animals that breathe air, have fur or hair and feed on their mother's milk as babies.	 
Bird	Birds have a beak, two legs, feathers and wings.	 

### Key vocabulary

- **animal** – a living creature



- **mammal** – an animal with fur or hair on its body



- **fur** – the fine, soft hair found on different animals



- **wild mammal** – a mammal that is not looked after by humans



- **pet** – an animal that is looked after by humans

Omnivores eat both plants and other animals.



Herbivores only eat plants.
