Vocabulary

Endangered A species of animal or plant that is at risk of becoming extinct.

Game Reserve A protected area of land where humans are allowed to live and carry out some different activities.

National Park A protected area of land where only tourism and research is allowed. No humans live there. Savannah Tropical grasslands with shrubs and trees but not much rainfall.
