School Attendance

Punctuality is also very important. Please remember that Years 1-6 should be lined up in the playground ready to come into school at <u>8.50am</u>. Foundation Stage pupils should be lined up ready to come in at <u>8.45am</u>. <u>Pupils should be collected promptly at the end of the school day</u>.



Attendance Fines

As we approach the end of the year, we kindly remind you that term-time holidays will not be authorised and may be subject to a Penalty Notice (Fine) from the Local Authority once it meets the threshold (10 sessions/ 5 days). Our attendance policy is available under 'Policies' on the school website with more information. In line with Government legislation, any attendance we believe is due to holiday, will be marked as a 'G' code for unauthorised. A reminder that this is a rolling period so absence at the end of term and beginning of next academic year will count towards that total.
