Romans: People who invaded and settled in Britain for over 400 years. They helped the People living in England defend themselves until they withdrew from England and returned to their homeland.


<u>Scots</u>: People from Ireland who invaded North England. They were fierce and powerful fighters.

Anglo-Saxon Place Names Still Used In England

Place Name	Meaning
Northumbria	Land of people living north of the River Humber.
East Anglia	Comes from the fact that the Angles first settled here.
Sussex	South Saxons.
Wessex	West Saxons.
Essex	East Saxons.
Mercia	Border people. Wessex
Kent	The Jutes who settled here called themselves 'Kentings'.
