Chaplaincy Pilgrimage to Wolverhampton

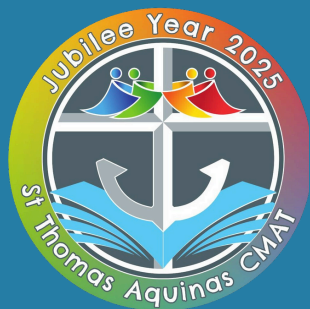

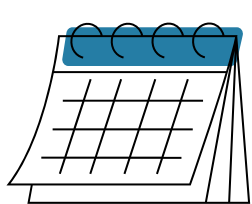
