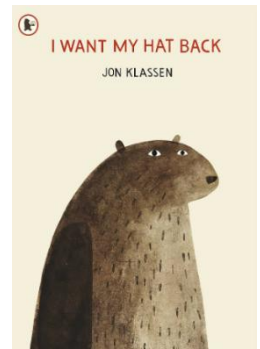


Year 1 October 2025

English

We will be reading the stories I want my hat back by Jon Klassen and Billy and The Beast by Nadia Shireen. We will be writing: questions, speech bubbles, lists, letters, story sequels, wanted posters, character descriptions, recipes and our own version of the text 'Defeat a Monster' narrative.



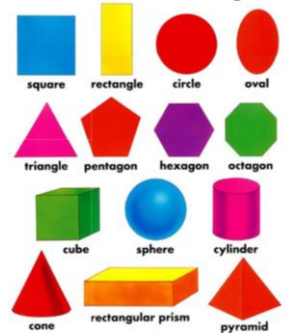
Maths

We are continuing to learn Addition and Subtraction to 10 and then we begin our topic on 2d and 3d Shape. Simple shape spotting can be very helpful so that children can identify shape with everyday life and become familiar with shape names and properties.



RE this term we are learning about Prophecy and Promise. We will encounter the story of the life of Jesus and recognise that for Christians this story reveals God's love by sending Jesus his only son. We will learn that Mary is important for Christians because she said yes to God.

Science

We will observe 'Seasonal Changes' in Autumn and Winter and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies. We then learn about 'Everyday Materials' identifying what an object is made from and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock.



Geography we are learning about our local area, the types of buildings, jobs and recreational aspects of it. We will draw and use some basic maps and learn about compass directions NSEW.

Computing we shall be learning about Online Safety. The children will learn about cyber bullying, safe websites and keeping their personal information safe.

P.E

We will be learning about 'Fitness': run, jump, co-ordination, balance, stamina, strength, agility, co-operation and perseverance. We also will be doing some dance, thinking about actions, dynamics, space, relationships, collaboration creativity, copy and repeat actions.

A reminder that **PE is on Monday and Friday** and on those days, children can still wear their polo shirt and joggers for ease when changing into kits. **Children should now be wearing winter uniform therefore they will need to wear a shirt or blouse and a tie, a St Peters jumper or cardigan.**
