## Pupils and Mobile Phones

There is a strict no mobile phones in school stance. Pupils may on occasion need to bring a mobile phone into school in the older year groups for exceptional circumstances (such as staying with a separated parent or walking home on their own – after informing the school of this). For these times the mobile phone **MUST** be turned off before entering the grounds and handed straight into the office staff. At the end of the day, (after collecting from the office) the phone must remain switched off, until the pupil is off the school site.

## Attendance Fines

We kindly remind you that term-time holidays will not be authorised and may be subject to a Penalty Notice (Fine) from the Local Authority once it meets the threshold (10 sessions/ 5 days). Our attendance policy is available under 'Policies' on the school website with more information. In line with Government legislation, any attendance we believe is due to holiday, will be marked as a 'G' code for unauthorised. A reminder that this is a rolling period so absence at the end of last term and beginning of this academic year will count towards that total.

## Free School Meals/Pupil Premium

The school receives funding to help pay for staff to support children's learning as well as resources for pupils who receive free school meals and or pupil premium. Pupils who are eligible receive a free hot meal, access to free school uniform, free school trips and discounted residential trips as well as an allowance to spend on after school clubs etc. During this cost-of-living crisis we are all experiencing, it is important to get access to any extra funding you may be entitled to.
