We will also provide weekly homework sheets to complete with your child at home. Also support your child to count and understand numbers, see shapes in the environment and have a go at number.

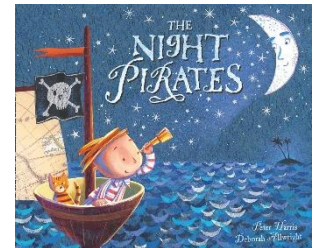
Literacy
