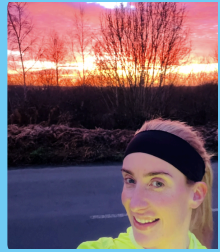
MEET LUCY THE LAY CHAPLAIN

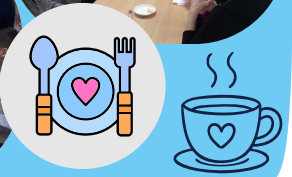
