Half Term**

Dear parents/ guardians,
Here is an overview of our learning for this half term. If you have any questions/concerns, please let us know as soon as possible so that we can help to resolve them.

Organisation

PE will be every **Monday** and **Tuesday**. Please ensure that PE kits are in school on these days and that earrings are removed at home, if your child is unable to remove them themselves. Long hair should be tied up.

Homework will be given out and marked on a Wednesday. Spellings will also be tested on Wednesdays. Reading records will be checked weekly (on Wednesday). We expect that children will have read at least 3 times, at home, each week, for a minimum of 10 minutes (or at least 5 pages). Reading records **MUST** be signed by an adult.

Maths

This half term we will be concentrating on the following aspects of maths:

- Number and place value
 - Numbers to 10 million
 - Compare and order any number
 - Round any number
 - Negative numbers
- The four operations (+ - x ÷)
 - Add and subtract whole numbers
 - Multiplication & Division
 - Division using factors
 - Long Division
 - Common Factors/ Multiples
 - Primes, Squares and Cubes
 - Order of operations
 - Reason from known facts

We will be carrying out reasoning activities on each of these areas to focus on mastery of the year 6 curriculum. Please also ensure that your child continues to practise their times tables regularly.

English

This half term, we will be looking at the extended picture book, 'The Arrival', which tells the story of a refugee. Using this book as inspiration, we will write a playscript, non-chronological report, diaries and a narrative.

In grammar, we will focus on: relative clauses, modal verbs, adverbs, parenthesis, expanded noun phrases, commas and present/past tense.

Our spelling will focus on the patterns: cious/tious, cial/tial, and learning the first column of the year 5/6 word list.

RE

In RE, we will be learning about 'Creation and Covenant' by using our new RED RE scheme. Within this topic, we will look at different covenants that were made with God, but with a focus on the one made with Moses. We will learn about cardinal and theological values and the Ten Commandments.

PSHE

We will be exploring the theme of 'Exploring emotions'. We will look at what to do if you fall out with someone and how people might be affected by it. We will then look at 'Difference and diversity' and consider how to be respectful, understanding how differences should be celebrated and stereotypes.

History

Our history will look at The Ancient Egyptians. We will be looking at who they were, life as an Egyptian, mummification, Egyptian rulers such as Tutankhamun, hieroglyphics and Egyptian Gods.

Science

We will look at 'Light'. In this unit, children will:

- Recognise light appears to travel in straight lines.
- Explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye.
- Explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to objects and then to our eyes.
- Explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.
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Art/ D&T

We will be focusing on the work of Giacomo Bala. We will be looking at how he captures motion within his art work and creating our own motion sketches and a final piece of art based on his work.

Computing

In our 'Online safety' unit we will be learning about stereotyping, how to spot secure websites and other ways to stay safe online.

Music

In music, we will be investigating 'pulse' through a range of music and creating our own piece of music using body percussion and voice. We will also start learning the Young Voices songs.
